



**“C-EH”
Commercial Electric Heat
Effective January 1, 2010**

Availability

This rate is available for all non-residential accounts, where the electric heating and cooling is separately metered and separately billed. This rate requires the installation of a second meter to record only the electric heating and cooling usage. All other electric energy usage must be recorded on the master meter and billed at the applicable standard rate.

Character of Service

The type of service rendered under this rate schedule shall be alternating current, sixty (60) Hertz, single-phase or three-phase at standard voltage.

Rate -- Monthly

Facilities Charge	\$21.00 per month
Energy Charge	\$.05628 per KWH

Conditions of Service

- The electric energy recorded on this meter must be used by the heating and cooling system(s) only. All other electric energy must be recorded and billed on the master meter, at the applicable rate.
- When this rate is in effect, the assigned transformer capacity of the master account may be reduced by the transformer capacity required to serve the electric heating and cooling load. The master account would then be billed at the applicable rate, as determined by the reduced assigned transformer capacity or metered peak demand.
- This is not a stand-by or supplemental rate. When a renewable energy generation system of 10 KW or larger is interconnected with this meter, this rate does not apply.
- This rate requires continuous service. If the account is disconnected for less than 12 months, all Facility Charges avoided during the disconnected period, plus a re-connect trip charge, shall be paid prior to re-establishing the account in the same name or that of another family member.

Wholesale Power Cost Adjustment

The above rates are subject to purchased power cost tracking adjustments as charged to Wabash County REMC by its power supplier.
