



**“LP” Rate
Large Power Service
Over 100 KW
Effective January 1, 2010**

Availability

Available for all general power uses, with a metered peak demand greater than 100 KW.

Character of Service

The type of service rendered under this rate schedule shall be alternating current, sixty (60) Hertz, single-phase or three-phase at a voltage agreed upon by Wabash County REMC.

Rate -- Monthly

Facilities Charge:	\$ 98.80 per month
Demand Charge:	\$ 14.43 per KW
Energy Charge:	\$.029061 per KWH

Minimum Monthly Charge

- The minimum monthly charge shall be the larger of the Facility Charge or minimum transformer capacity charge (KVA minimum) of \$1.00 for each KVA or fractional KVA of transformer capacity that is installed to serve this load, or
- Where the electrical load is primarily seasonal farm-related grain drying or crop irrigation, the member may guarantee an annual minimum payment (Annual Contract) equal to twelve (12) times the monthly KVA minimum charge as computed above. In this case, bills will be rendered for actual energy usage plus Facility Charge each month, without regard for the computed monthly minimum stated above. If at the end of the year, the total charge is less than the minimum annual payment (Annual Contract), a charge for the difference shall be added to the 12th month bill, or
- Minimum charge as may be specified in a supplemental contract between Wabash County REMC and member.

Determination of Billing Demand

The billing demand shall be the maximum average kilowatt load recorded during any period of fifteen (15) consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered, as recorded by the REMC’s maximum load meter. As provided below, an adjustment for Power Factor shall be applied.

Power Factor

The member agrees to maintain unity power factor. Wabash County REMC reserves the right to measure Power Factor at any point. Should such measurements indicate the Power Factor at peak demand is less than 95%; the recorded maximum billing demand shall be adjusted by multiplying the metered demand (KW) by 95% and dividing by the Power Factor percentage recorded.

Terms and Conditions of Service

- The member shall be required to enter into a written agreement stating the character of load, minimum contract period, minimum monthly charge, and any other charges.
- The residence usage may be included on this meter, or it can be separately metered and billed under the Residential rate.
- For purposes of establishing the KVA capacity, three-phase banks utilizing open-delta configuration will be rated at 66% of installed KVA size, to determine the transformer capacity available.
- Individual single-phase electric motors are limited to a maximum of 10 horsepower, unless approved by Wabash County REMC.
- Wabash County REMC may require corrective measures or devices for any motor or apparatus, which in the opinion of Wabash County REMC will cause voltage fluctuation to other members. Unless otherwise permitted, the maximum primary voltage fluctuation is three percent (3%).
- Wabash County REMC will furnish and maintain at its expense, one transformation and service drop from its existing primary line. Primary line extensions required to serve the meter point are subject to existing line extension policies.
 - When the member requests a primary or secondary line extension beyond the meter point, such poles, wires and other electrical equipment shall be installed and maintained at the member's expense.
- Should the electrical energy furnished under this rate schedule be metered on the primary side of the service transformer, Wabash County REMC shall deduct 1½% of the total energy revenue for that billing month.
- This is not a stand-by or supplemental rate. When a renewable energy generation system of 10 KW or larger is interconnected with this meter, this rate does not apply.
- This rate requires continuous service. If the account is disconnected for less than 12 months, all Facility and Minimum charges avoided during the disconnected period, plus a re-connect trip charge, shall be paid prior to re-establishing the account in the same name or another family member.

Wholesale Power Cost Adjustment

The above rates are subject to purchased power cost tracking adjustments as charged to Wabash County REMC by its power supplier.
