



Wabash County REMC is offering an incentive to retail residential members for installing a new, energy efficient all electric air source or ground source heat pump heating and cooling system. This rebate is for new construction only. Multiple rebates are also being offered through the state, and a federal tax credit worth up to 30% of your new system’s cost is available until the end of the year.

**Eligibility**

- Members who are building a new home.
- Members who install an air source heat pump or geothermal heat pump that meets the minimum efficiency criteria.
- Members who are upgrading an existing system are not eligible for this rebate.
- Homes switching from gas, propane, wood or other forms of heating fuel are not eligible for this rebate.

**Details**

- You can pair this rebate with any existing state, federal or local rebate or tax credits.
- The rebate is \$500 for a geothermal and \$350 for an air source heat pump (residential applications only).
- All rebates will be paid as bill credits.
- SEER, HSPF, COP AND EER verification will be by AHRI certification sheet. Ask your HVAC contractor for one.
- The rebate will be paid to members who are building a new home and are installing an all-electric air source heat pump or a geothermal system with a verified AHRI minimum efficiency of:

**How to claim your rebate**

- Present your completed rebate form with proof of purchase, installation, and AHRI certificate.
- Allow 6 to 8 weeks for rebates to be processed.
