



## “SL” Rate Outdoor Security Lighting Effective January 1, 2012

---

### Availability

Available when the security light can be mounted on a Wabash County REMC-owned pole. Security lighting service will only be rendered where in the opinion of Wabash County REMC; such lights are readily accessible for maintenance.

### Monthly Rate per Fixture

<u>Type of Fixture</u>	<u>Lamp Size</u>	<u>Charge on Existing Pole</u>
Mercury	175 Watts	\$9.14
Mercury	400 Watts	\$13.62
Mercury Flood	400 Watts	\$14.65

### Billing

The security light charge shall be plainly shown on the member’s billing statement and shall be paid at the same time and on the same terms as the member’s regular bill.

### Extra Charges

For members requesting the lighting fixture at a point other than where Wabash County REMC has an existing pole, the customer shall pay the installation labor and material charges to install a pole and its wiring to that location.

When a separate transformer is required or the member requesting the lighting service does not have an active billing account, a Facilities Charge equal to that of the residential rate shall be added to the monthly security light charge.

### Conditions of Service

- The outdoor security lighting fixture and the electric energy it uses, is furnished by Wabash County REMC. The lighting equipment shall remain the property of Wabash County REMC.
- Lamp replacements will be furnished and installed by Wabash County REMC, except in cases of vandalism or willful destruction.
- Monthly rate shall not be prorated for temporary service interruption. It shall be the responsibility of the member to notify Wabash County REMC of the need for maintenance of the lighting fixture. Maintenance will be performed during regular working hours.

### Terms of Contract

Service under this schedule is for a term of not less than one (1) year.

### Termination of service

The member may request termination of security light service at his option and Wabash County REMC will remove its property upon such notice with reasonable diligence. Wabash County REMC may also remove its fixture and cancel the security lighting service where:

- Bills are unpaid,
- When the service is no longer being made available,

- Whenever such action is necessary to protect Wabash County REMC from fraud or abuse.
